KICKING off Bushido's events this month on June 7 is none other than Bushido's third anniversary! This year, there are three special DJs performing on one night to mark the success of one of the best nightspots in Bahrain.

Having had a pretty busy few months with the Formula One, June 7 is the nominated day for the celebrations. The DJs are all from Bushido's sister properties. First up we have DJ Ravin from Buddha-Bar Paris. Then for a mix of world and Latino vibes say hello to Carlos Campos from Barrio Latino Paris. Last, but not least, is DJ Dara Singh of Bushido States – all these DJs have played a pretty big role in the success of Bushido and if this year's anniversary is anything to go by, we look forward to seeing how big the 10-year celebrations will be!

The second event of the month celebrates the Fête de la Musique. Also known as World Music Day, it was first broached in 1976 by the American musician Joel Cohen and then employed by the national French radio station France Musique. Since that point, it was taken up by French Music and Dance director Maurice Fleuret for Minister of Culture Jack Lang in 1981.

Marking a 30-year point since it first took part in Paris, the festival is set to take place at Bushido this year on June 21, where jazz enthusiasts can marvel at the talents of Eric Seva. Having recorded more than 80 albums, he has spent the past 25 years discovering musicians, cultures and musical styles.

With a strong reputation already built, he has collaborated with Chris Rea (on his European tour), Celine Dion and Michel Jarre, to name a few. Packed with emotion and intense style, Eric is a genius on the saxophone and the vocals. Unique and soulfully addictive, this man is worth a watch.
